The Fruit of the Spirit: & the Call to Love One Another
²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. (Galatians 5:22-23 ESV)
1. Beloved, let us love one another:
• for love is from God
● because we are born of God
● because we know God
2. Beloved, we ought to love one another:
• hospies Cod so loved us

because God so loved us

for God abides in us

• for God's love is perfected in us

3. How to love one another (two examples from Galatians 5)

• Use our freedom in Christ to love & serve one another (vs13-15)

• Walk by the Spirit & we will not gratify the desires of the flesh (v16)

Excursus: John's litmus test for Knowing Christ/Having Eternal Life

Highlights listed below are some insights & themes adapted from various sources including: 1 – 3 JOHN, by Robert W. Yarbrough (ECNT) & The ESV Study Bible (Crossway)

In The Gospel of John, John writes that we might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and have life in His name (Jn 20:30-31). In 1 John, John writes to those who believe in the name of the Son of God (Jesus Christ) so that we might know that we have eternal life (1Jn 5:13). Listed below are three key themes in 1 John which give us assurance that we know Christ and have eternal life (a litmus test for who truly believes in Him, is born of God).

Doctrine: if we believe Jesus Christ is the Son of God (1:1ff; 3:23; 4:1; 5:1)

Ethical: if we obey God's commands (1:5ff; 2:3ff; 3:4ff; 5:16ff)

Relational: if we love one another (2:9ff; 3:10ff; 4:7ff; 5:1ff)
