- 1. Faith without Works is Dead
- Saving faith includes steadfastness, love & obedience to Christ: by God's power & for His glory

• Believing in God like the demons do: Saving faith is evidenced by obedience to our Lord Jesus Christ

- 3. <u>Understanding James in light of Paul</u> (adapted from Craig Blomberg & Mariam Kamell, *James*, ECNT)
- Paul rejects a sinner's ability to gain righteousness thru pre-conversion works of the law (Ro 3:21ff; 9:30ff)

- Why are some professing Christians not Walking the Talk?
- \rightarrow they are new in the faith
- \rightarrow they are in rebellion and/or deceived
- \rightarrow they are not really Christians
- 2. Be on Guard against a Dead Faith
- Claiming to have faith without works: Saving faith is evidenced by the loving-care of a brother or sister in need

- James rejects the ability to be saved by claiming to have faith without the **post-conversion** works **of love & obedience** (Jm 2:14ff)

- Rahab the prostitute
