Joyfully Obeying Christ's Command to Baptize

1. We Make Disciples of Jesus Christ: • because He has been given all authority • by going to all nations • by baptizing in the name of the Trinity • by teaching all He has commanded us • knowing that He is with us always 2. We Seek a Biblical View of Baptism: • to baptize means to immerse, to cleanse by dipping, to wash with water (& implies a permanent change)

• it visibly demonstrates the gospel: our identification w/ Christ

(His death & resurrection) & cleansing of our sins

• in the NT, those who heard & believed the word were baptized (usually immediately & sometimes as families)

• our church baptizes believers (& we welcome Christians into membership who have been baptized as infants)

3. We Make Water Baptism a Priority:

- because Jesus commanded us to baptize
- to publicly profess our faith in, & our identification with, Jesus Christ
- as the church who is affirming a believer's faith & welcoming him or her into the family of God
- as the church who is celebrating God's saving grace & a sinner's faith in Jesus Christ
