The Exiles' Prayer: for the Welfare of Our Babylonian World

1. Our Biblical Call as Exiles

• the LORD sent His people into Babylonian captivity: because of their sin, for Israel's long term good & God's glorious-unfolding plan

• We are sojourners & exiles in a Babylonian-like world: called to holy living & godly witness

2. Our High Calling as Exiles

• the LORD called the Exiles to live among, seek the welfare of & pray for the city: the Babylonian people who had enslaved them

• Embrace Christ's incarnational, sanctifying call to be salt & light: loving & praying for our neighbors & our enemies

3. The Danger of Exile-Rejecting False Prophets

• the LORD rebuked & judged the false prophets – and warned the exiles not to be deceived by them

• Embrace a sojourner-exile worldview, calling & heart: while rejecting the prosperity & political false gospels of this age

4. The Eternal Blessings of Our Promise-Keeping God

• the LORD told the exiles He would fulfill His promise to them: and exhorted them to pray & seek Him with all their heart...

• Let's be Jeremiah 29:7 Christians waiting for our Jeremiah 29:11 future – exiles empowered by our eschatological hope in Christ
